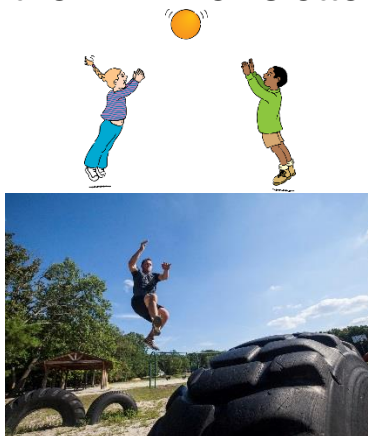
THE BATTELL ARTS FOUNDATION

Spring Break is almost here, along with our Jump Rope for Heart day Monday April 8th. Please remember that this will be an event and permission slips are needed in order for your student to participate; the signed permission slip/brochure, signed scrap paper or email are all acceptable forms. For those students who do not have their slip in, they will play a tag game and have jump ropes to use during this time. Thank you!

Kindergarten through Second Grade:

Students in Kindergarten through Second Grade will finish up their jump rope and critical thinking unit! They should know the heart very well by now. Feel free to ask them questions about how to keep our heart healthy! We will finish out the month of April with Striking, Catching and Throwing. The skills involved in this unit will include:

- Striking with a foam paddle or racquet
- Striking with a plastic long handled implement (bat)
- Underhand tossing
- Overhand throwing
- Two handed catching

Third through Sixth Grade:

Students in Third through Sixth Grade will finish up their Badminton Unit and move on to their American Ninja Warrior Unit! Students will participate in an event after spring break, including all the skills from our American Ninja Warrior Unit:

- Leaping, Jumping over objects, up to and onto objects
- Balancing on one foot or two feet
- Upper body and Lower Body muscular strength
- Muscular Endurance on the various rope swings
- Flexibility
